It may also spread by touching a surface or object that has the virus on it, then touching your mouth, nose, or eyes. Some evidence suggests that COVID-19 can live on certain surfaces for several days.

#### **Here's what we're doing:**

We have enhanced our cleaning procedure in all areas, giving special attention to clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces such as tables, chairs, toilets, light switches, and doorknobs. Our staff perform routine cleaning and sanitising all areas, including toys and the outside area.

Please refer to our risk assessment and Covid Policy. We have implemented a policy designed to limit physical interactions between employees, parents and visitors in our location, as well as physical interactions among our employees. It is not possible to physically social distance from the children that we care for and will have strict policies and procedures in place to keep the setting clean between each session. We have also developed a process for screening our employees for COVID-19 symptoms and exposure.

Our employees will wear aprons and disposable gloves whilst changing the children and all areas will be disinfected regularly.

We are restricting access to our office. Any visitors entering our office or building must wear masks.

To further limit physical interactions, we are asking parents to drop off the children at the door and our staff will help the children to place their belongings on their pegs and wash their hands before entering the playroom.

We will have a one-way system where we will ask parents to stand at the gate to drop off the children near the front door.

**Here's what you can do:**

Staying healthy and mitigating the risk of contracting COVID-19 will require your help. Protect yourself and exercise social responsibility. Maintain at least six (6) feet social distancing from others when possible. Wear a mask, particularly in places like grocery stores and other public-serving businesses. Wash your hands using soap and water for at least twenty (20) seconds as frequently as possible. Carry hand sanitizer and use it frequently. During your stay, regularly clean and wipe down high-touch surfaces. Clean and wipe down personal items such as phones and wallets, and clean areas inside of your vehicles, such as steering wheels. Avoid contact with others who are sick. If you feel sick, isolate yourself from others and seek medical attention.
